Beginner's Lace

Easy Lace Scarf

This very easy lace pattern, feather and fan, is a great place for beginners to start knitting open work. Finished here in Indulgence, our elegant 60/40 merino/silk yarn, this scarf will be a pleasure to knit and to wear!

Yarn Requirements: 2 skeins of Indulgence or approximately 200yds of worsted weight yarn

Needle Size: US10

Instructions:

Cast on 48 stitches.

Knit 4 rows in garter stitch to form the starting edge. (knit every row)

Pattern:

Row 1: K1P1(seed stitch) for 6 stitches, Knit across to the last 6 stitches, then K1,P1 to the end of the row

Row 2: Seed stitch for the first 6 st, Purl across to last 6 st, seed stitch to the end of row.

Row 3: Seed stitch for the first 6 stitches,(K2tog.) 3 times, (YO, K1), 6 times, (K2tog) 3 times, seed stitch for the last 6 stitches.

Row 4: Repeat Row 2.

Continue these 4 rows to the desired scarf length. End with 4 rows of garter stitch.

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
