

# Blue Ridge Yarns

## Silk Shimmer Scarf

Simple yet elegant, this is a one skein project using our Silk Shimmer yarn.

### Materials

1 skein of Silk Shimmer (Blue Ridge Yarns) 312yds/sk  
US 6 Strait needles

### Directions

cast on 36 stitches.

- Row 1: (K4, P4) across, ending with a K4
- Row 2: K1, (P4, K4) across, ending with a P3
- Row 3: K2, (P4, K4) across, ending with a P2
- Row 4: K3, (P4, K4) across, ending with a P1
- Row 5: (P4, K4) across, ending with a P4
- Row 6: P1, (K4, P4) across, ending with a K3
- Row 7: P2, (K4, P4) across, ending with a K2
- Row 8: P3, (K4, P4) across, ending with a K1
- Row 9: (K4, P4) across, ending with a K4.

Once your pattern has been established, you can continue knitting by looking at your work at the beginning of each row to maintain the twill design. Make your project wider by adding stitches in multiples of 8.

Knit until 5-6 yards of yarn remains. Cast off and then using a crochet hook, you may finish the edges of the scarf with a single crochet.
